

## POLICY 5131, INTRAMURAL ATHLETICS PROGRAM

The Board of Education supports intramural athletic competition with due regard for the health and safety of the participants as part of its mission to help all students "...achieve their full human potential."

In addition to the development of physical fitness, strength, and agility, intramural athletic competition teaches the value of working together in teams, the value in establishing and striving to reach goals, and the value in the physical and mental discipline fundamental to the focus required for success in athletic competition.

The Director of Intramurals, in consultation with the ~~Director~~ Assistant Principal ~~for~~ Student Activities and the ~~Assistant Superintendent for Pupil Support Services~~ Principal, shall promulgate rules governing practices and contests consistent with the established procedures for use of facilities and the use of facilities and the rules for ~~access to school property as detailed in the~~ General Catalog ~~the rules for~~ behavior detailed in the *Code of Conduct*, and the rules governing fair play and safety of the involved sport.
