

SUMMER SCHOOL ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES

Registration: Wednesday, May 14, 2008, 7:00 P.M. - North Cafeteria
Testing: Wednesday, May 21, 2008, 7:00 P.M. - North Cafeteria

Both nights of registration must be attended!

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome all eligible students to Driver Education.

Registration will take place on two nights. The 1st part of registration will be held at Oak Park and River Forest High School on Wednesday, May 14, 2008, in the North Cafeteria **promptly at 7:00 P.M.** At this time, the student will, fill out an application for a Learner's Permit, a student record card, and receive information on how to obtain a permit from the Secretary of State for final registration. The student must be at least **fifteen** before entering a driver education course, with the older students receiving priority. Students must have passed 8 classes in the last calendar year to take Drivers Education.

At this time, all students should follow the directions listed below to qualify for registration:

1. Bring a black ballpoint pen when you come to register.
2. If you have knowledge of any former or present medical condition that could influence driving, please have your family doctor fill out an official Secretary of State form to take to the Secretary of State's office. (Get form from O.P.R.F.)
3. Make sure that your eyes are corrected to 20/40 or better visual acuity. If glasses are needed, please obtain them as soon as possible, since the vision test will be administered at the Secretary of State office.
4. Bring your Social Security number. If you don't already have one, the nearest Social Security office is located at 230 N. Mannheim Road in Hillside. (Approximately 2 miles south of North Avenue and 3 blocks north of the I-290 Eisenhower Expressway on Mannheim Road.) Telephone #708-544-4438.
5. You will be given a Rules of the Road book to study, and be tested at the Secretary of State facility in order to complete Driver Education registration.

The second night or part of registration will be held on Wednesday, May 21, 2008, **promptly at 7:00 P.M.** The final registration will be held in the North Cafeteria and at this time the student **must have:**

1. A current Illinois Learner Permit acquired from the Secretary of State.
2. A check for \$330.00 for tuition and fees payable to Oak Park and River Forest High School. Students who are sophomores or older presently enrolled at Oak Park and River Forest High School and have already paid Sophomore fees will pay tuition of \$180.00. OPRF freshman and students repeating the lab instruction portion of the course will need to pay the \$330.00 tuition and lab fees.

3. Parent's permission for taking the course will be indicated by their signature on the student record card.

A student must have attended and completed registration materials on the first night in order to finalize and complete registration on Wednesday, May 21, 2008. The student will have to show their proof of passing 8 classes to keep their assigned place in Summer School on the first day of school.

Students need to be aware of the Summer School Schedule so that camps, conferences, summer employment, or other Summer School Subjects planned may be correlated and not interfere.
