HOMECOMING & KING OF HEARTS DANCES

There are two dress-up dances each year. The Homecoming Dance is in the fall and the King of Hearts Dance in February.

- **DATES/LOCATION:** Homecoming ~ October 3, 2009– Field House
King of Hearts, February 6, 2010 – Student Center
- **Times:** 7:00 – 10:00 p.m.
- **Arrival:** Doors open at 7:00 p.m. No one will be admitted after 7:45 p.m. unless prior arrangements are made with the Assistant Principal for Student Activities.
- **Parking:** The Parking Garage or street parking is available.
- **TICKETS:**
 - Tickets can be purchased in advance at the OPRF Box Office (usually sold during lunch and after school several weeks before of the dance) or online at <http://oprfs.revtrak.net/tek9.asp>
 - Tickets may be purchased individually.
 - Tickets WILL NOT be sold at the door.
- **ID:**
 - Students must have their **CURRENT SCHOOL ID WITH THEM TO BE ADMITTED.**
- **ATTIRE:**
 - Dresses, dress pants, dress skirts; suit or sport coat, tie (optional) dress shoes and a collared shirt.
 - Note: No t-shirts or blue jeans, jean skirts, or other denim clothing.
- **GUESTS:**
 - Guest Permission Forms must be completed for each guest. Guest permission forms are available in the Dean and Counselor's office.
 - **Guest permission forms must be completed and signed by your dean and presented when purchasing tickets.** A copy of the Guest Permission Form must be brought to the dance for check in at the door. Guests must also have their own current photo ID, driver's license or state ID.
 - Guests must be 9th grade or above or under 21 years of age in order to attend the dance.
 - An OPRFHS student must accompany the Guest.

The only formal dance of the year, primarily attended by Juniors and Seniors. Detailed Prom information, -- including time, ticket sales, cost and information about the After Prom Party -- will be mailed to all Juniors and Seniors in March.

- **DATE/LOCATION:** May 15, 2010 ~ Hyatt Regency in Chicago
- **Arrival:** Doors open at 6:30 p.m. No one will be admitted after 7:30 p.m.
- **Time:** 6:30 – 11:00 p.m. (Please allow ample time for parking)
- **Parking:** Parking on the street is very limited; however, discount parking is available at the Hyatt.
- **TICKETS:** Tickets may be purchased individually. Tickets will be approximately \$100 per person. Tickets must be purchased in advance at the OPRF Box Office on designated days or can be purchased online at <http://oprfs.revtrak.net/tek9.asp>
- **ID:**
 - Students must have their **CURRENT SCHOOL ID WITH THEM TO BE ADMITTED.**
- **ATTIRE:**
 - **Formal attire is required.** Elegant dresses, tuxedos or formal business suit, shirt /tie, and dress shoes.
 - Note: No t-shirts or blue jeans, jean skirts, or other denim clothing.

 - 1st offense: 10 minute time out
 - 2nd offense: Parents will be called, and you will be asked to leave without a refund
