

**District Suspension/Expulsion Review Process
for Special Education Students**

The Suspension/Expulsion Review Process is for out-of-school student suspensions of 1-10 days. Alternative boxes are an indication that each group/team may choose to exercise other options in lieu of the issued suspension. A 10-day Out-of-School Suspension (OSS) may result in a recommendation for expulsion at any point along the process. Parent appeals may be made to the individuals/Board of Education and at the steps so indicated, except in instances in which the IEP dictates placement-related services.
