John Montgomery Belk Scholarship

Davidson's John Montgomery Belk Scholarship program honors ten students with demonstrated intellectual and personal success and significant leadership in their high school. This annually renewable scholarship is equivalent to the College's comprehensive fees (in 2007-2008 valued at \$40,814), plus two summer stipends (up to \$3,000 per stipend) to pursue further enrichment opportunities. **Students must be nominated by their Counselor.** Only one student from OPRF may be nominated for this scholarship. Nominees are urged to complete an application to Davidson by December 1, 2007. Nomination forms and more information are available in the Scholarship File in the College & Career Center. ➤ **University Honors Program**

First-time freshmen are eligible to apply to Eastern's University Honors Program. For consideration, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 26 ACT or better (1100 SAT) and top 10% of class, or
- 3.5/4.0 GPA

All applicants meeting these criteria are encouraged to apply for competitive scholarships and tuition waivers. More information and applications are available in the Scholarship File in the College & Career Center, or online at www.eiu.edu/~honors.

➤ **Presidential Scholars Program**

First-time freshmen are eligible to apply to Eastern's Presidential Scholars Program. For consideration, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 30 ACT and either 3.5/4.0 GPA or top 10% of class, or
- 28 ACT and either 3.75/4.0 GPA or top 5% of class

Ohio Wesleyan University is offering approximately 140 academic scholarships through their Honors Program. Scholarships include:

- **Presidential Scholarships** – Twenty-five full-tuition awards of more than \$31,000
- **Trustee Scholarships** – Sixty three-fourth tuition awards of more than \$23,000
- **Faculty Scholarships** – Sixty half-tuition awards of more than \$15,700

Hunt Leadership Scholarship

The Hunt Leadership Scholars Award is for full SMU tuition and fees, less the amount of resident tuition and fees at the leading public school in the student's state of residency. If eligible, a student can be awarded need-based aid in addition to the Hunt Scholarship. Criteria for this award include:

- Demonstrated Extraordinary Leadership through high school organizations such as class officer, editor of school newspaper, founder of an organization, senior leadership in scouting or other service organizations, etc.
- Submission of Hunt Essay and completed first-year application for admission to SMU
- Rank in top 25% of graduating class
- Composite SAT of 1230 for Math and Critical Reading, or ACT Composite of 28
- Completion of strong college preparatory curriculum, including AP and honors courses
- Submission of a letter of recommendation from a counselor or teacher

Medallion Scholarship Competition

Western Michigan University recognizes superior academic achievement through the Medallion Scholarship Program. The Program begins with the Medallion Scholarship Competition held on WMU's campus on January 26, 2008. This competition gives students the opportunity to compete for one of seventeen Medallion Scholarships valued at \$40,000 over four years. Interested students must be high school seniors entering WMU in the fall of 2008 as a degree-seeking student, and have a cumulative GPA of 3.7 or higher **and** an ACT composite score of 26 or higher (SAT math/verbal of 1170 or higher).
