

Directions for Off-Campus Access to the Library Subscription Databases via *My Virtual Desktop*

My Virtual Desktop allows you to log into the school's network off campus. You are able to access the school's online resources off campus as though you were in school. Therefore, you do not have to use passwords to access the subscription databases provided by the library.

1. Go to the school's homepage at <http://www.oprfhs.org>
2. Scroll down to the *Quick Links* near the bottom of the page. Select the *Library Services* link, and then select *Databases*. Next, select the URL provided for *My Virtual Desktop* near the top of the page.

3. Click on this URL, and you will be see the *Virtual Desktop Services* page for students, faculty and staff access. Enter your username and password. It should be the same as your OPRF login.
4. Click *My Virtual Desktop*. (Please note: Java compatibility is required.)
5. Click "Trust" or "Connect."
6. Re-enter your username and password. Make sure that the domain is OPRFAD.
7. This will take you to the desktop with the icons on it. You must select the **globe icon** to obtain the *Huskienet Resources Page*.
8. Select "Library Databases" under the "Library" tab. Proceed to select any database on the list. You should **not** have to provide a user-id or password.
